The Trussell Trust Road Show took place in Limavady on 21st May. Dr Sinead Furey, from the University of Ulster talked about hunger



and poverty in Northern Ireland. Emma Revie, Chief Executive of the Trussell Trust, and her Team then looked at, the services which exist to meet the need, showing that 1.6million food parcels were given out through the Trussell Trust Network of Foodbanks in 2019, an increase of 19%. In the afternoon we had the opportunity to reflect on what we as Foodbanks do and how we might be a Network for Change to work towards a day when Foodbanks are no longer needed.
