This enables parents who are struggling to provide the estimated £30 - £40 per week for the extra food required over the holidays to access a referral agency and get a voucher for three days' supply of food from Larne Foodbank . Larne foodbank has been awarded a grant to provide computer access for clients to update their compulsory online benefit information and to do job searches. We hope that this will provide access to those who do not have their own internet access. The grant was provided by ASDA /Trussell Trust and has enabled us to purchase equipment and infrastructure to provide this important service.
