## Volunteers

Larne Foodbank is operated by a wonderful group of dedicated volunteers most of whom have been involved since the foodbank began in 2013. The volunteers receive donations of food and toiletries each Monday. The food is weighed, dated and sorted. Then on four distribution sessions our volunteers meet people with a referral voucher and offer a welcome, a cup of tea and the opportunity to be listened to. Others pack bags with essential tins and packets of food to feed the individual or family for three days. Our volunteers love to be able to give not only the essentials but also a little treat like a bar of chocolate such is their care for each individual who comes to the foodbank. Our volunteers also sit on the

Management Committee and take the decisions necessary to ensure the smooth running of the Foodbank.

We are indebted to each volunteer for the part they play, the time and commitment they give week by week.
