In November and December Larne foodbank received 4277kg of donations of food and toiletries. This amazing amount of food and toiletries came from 21 local churches, 8 local schools, 13 local businesses, 5 local organisations and 4 referral agencies. We are so grateful to the many, many people that represents who gave us enough to meet the needs of local people in crisis.

Numbers of people fed. In October, November and December the Distribution Volunteers at Larne Foodbank fulfilled 172 vouchers, feeding 252 adults and 135 children, a total of 387 people.



230 Christmas Hampers Larne Foodbank along with our partners, Christians Against Poverty and the Salvation Army gave out 230 Christmas Hampers to those refereed to us as struggling over Christmas. We want to pass on the thankful response of those who received hampers. One lady phoned to say she had just opened the box and it contained exactly what she needed.
