Larne foodbank HAS REMAINED OPEN TO MEET THE 135% INCREASED NEED IN OUR LOCAL COMMUNITY

Since lockdown began on 23rd March 2020 Larne Foodbank has seen a 135% increase in the number of people referred to us. We know that the Department for Communities and various community groups throughout the area have also been providing food to those who have been shielding. It has been great to see this sense of community during such a challenging time. These community parcels are expected to stop over the next few weeks as people begin to be able to shop again for themselves. At Larne Foodbank we have continued to meet the needs of those who are struggling to eat because of poverty. We expect that as we move forward that we will continue to see this increased need for our services.
