foodbank Held Its 2020 AGM on 20th August by Zoom

Those who joined were informed about the work of Larne foodbank during the year April 2019 to March 2020. To Summarise Larne Foodbank fulfilled 547 vouchers. This provided food and toiletries to a total of 1249 people. Food weighing 14 tonnes was donated and just under 15 tonnes was given out to those in food poverty in our community.

The effect of COVID 19

Since lockdown began in March 2020 we have already fulfilled 335 vouchers providing food, toiletries and cleaning products to 861 people, 323 of whom were children. We are aware that furlough pay is still being provided and we are likely to see an even more dramatic increase in demand for our service towards the end of October when furlough finishes.
