HALF YEARLY FIGURES

In 2016, April to September, Larne Foodbank gave out three days supply of food to 309 adults and 94 children, a total of 403 people. This year, 2017, LFB has fed 404 adults, 228 children, a total of 632 people. We are so grateful to those who make it possible. EMERGENCY MOBILE PHONE

There are currently only three people sharing the rotation of the emergency phone and we would like to invite others to volunteer in order that we can have regular rotation for shorter periods.

The purpose of holding the emergency phone is to answer any calls outside office hours and signpost them to opening hours of distribution or to the office, whichever is appropriate. On average we receive two or three calls per month. On the rare occasion that someone needs food urgently you will have a colleague to accompany you to pack up the food. This will be at a time that suits you.
